We, the members of the Macon County Grand Jury for this February 2020 term of Criminal Court have undertaken to fulfill our duties as required by law.

We have duly considered all matters, which have been brought to our attention and rendered a proper return thereon.

We have inspected the bonds of the county officials and found them to be in proper form and solvent.

We have inspected the Macon County Courthouse and found it to be clean, well-maintained and in a good state of repair with the following exceptions:

1. The Court room has a water leak.
2. The wall is flaking in court room and the storage room off of te court room.
3. The main hallway has a water leak.
4. The Mayor's secretary's office has a water leak.
5. Court Records stored haphazardly in Court room storage area.
6. Register of Deeds back office continues to show signs of mold underneath the windows.

We have inspected the Macon County Jail and found it clean, well-maintained and in a good state of repair with the following exceptions:

1. The seal on the refrigerator is very loose.
2. The sleeping mats are not thick enough for prisoner sleeping.
3. In the tower, the ceiling vents have mold surrounding them.
4. 5 mop buckets in main hallways to tower.
5. The windows in the tower should have better, more discreet coverings,

Now, having finished our duties as set out in our oath and instructions, we ask to be dismissed until further call of the Court.
