Complaint Procedures:

Macon County has established a discrimination complaint procedure and will take prompt and reasonable action to investigate and eliminate discrimination when found. Any person who believes that he or she has been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI has a right to file a formal complaint with Macon County. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with the Macon County Title VI Coordinator within one hundred eighty (180) calendar days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence.
