

The Macon County Road Department will be closed Monday June 22, 2020 through Friday July 3, 2020 and reopen Monday July 6, 2020 due to the COVID-19 virus. Unfortunately, several County Road employees and Road Department Superintendent Audie Cook have tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. Under current health department guidelines, it is recommended that those employees remain off from work and quarantine for 14 days.
