

Motion # 19 by Hesson, 2nd by Snow to suspend the rules and to pass a resolution to extend the time for receiving the 2% discount for payment of real property taxes for 30 days and a 1% discount for payment of real property taxes for 60 days due to the property tax notices not being mailed on the first Monday of October. With the time period for the 2% discount being 30 days from the date the tax notice was mailed and for the 1% discount the taxes being paid within 60 days of the tax notice being mailed out.


