In the Committee of the Whole, Mayor Jones informed the commissioners that the Planning notice that was questioned regarding the recent special exception issued for property which allowed a shooting range approval was done correctly. The procedure for special exceptions and land zoning changes was approved several years ago. Mayor Jones said he was told the organization had met all necessary guidelines to allow the special exception. A motion in the past by the legislative body was made to only advertise in one paper due to cost. Mayor Jones told the commissioners that although everything was done properly he felt the advertisement for property changes such as special exceptions and zoning changes should be advertised better. The mayor said in his opinion, the notice that was run in the paper was like reading the fine print in a document. The Mayor told the commissioners he felt the notices should be run in both local papers, in larger print and that signage should be placed on the properties. He also stated this cost should be at the expense of the requesting party.

Attorney Holliman addressed the commissioners regarding these notices. He stated that the Planning Commission would need to change their procedures and send it back to the full court for approval. Discussion ensued

King, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Hughes to run zoning advertisements in both newspapers with a 3x5 notice, also to place signage on the property that is being zoned, along with a letter to the adjoining property owners. This request will be taken to the Planning Commission for approval and then brought back to the County Commission at the appropriate time.


